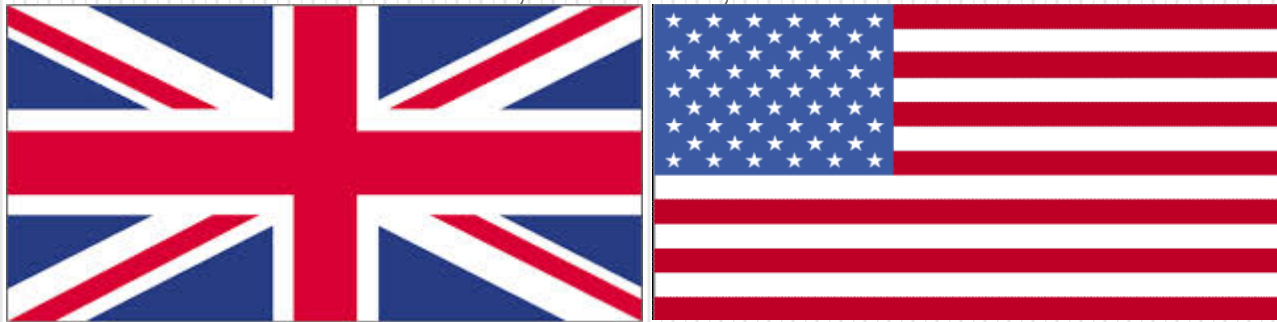


Schools in UK and USA

Britain

- Education is compulsory between ages of 5 and 16
- Primary school lasts until the age of 11
- The pupils have teacher who teaches all subjects

3 types of secondary schools

1. Comprehensive school
2. Grammar school
3. Public school

Daily routine

- In most schools the pupils have to wear school uniforms
- The lesson usually starts at 9 o'clock
- They all gather together and listen to the school headmistress's or headmaster's welcoming words
- The pupils usually have four lessons before the lunch break which lasts an hour and the class finishes around 3.45

USA

- Compulsory school starts at the age of 6
- At the age of 12, children start to attend junior high school
- When the pupils are 14 years old they start going to senior high school
- At the age of 18, young people enter colleges which are not free

Daily routine

- The classes usually start at 7 or 8 in the morning
- The classes finish at 2.30 or 3
- Subjects: English, science, social sciences and physical education
- Elective subjects: arts, computer science, foreign languages, technology
